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A note on results at or above 100%

Sometimes an individual analyte or a calculated total comes back at or slightly above 100%. This isn't an error. Every quantitative measurement has a margin of uncertainty, and when a sample is very high in purity or concentration, that margin can push the reported value past 100%. Per our methods, accredited to the ISO/IEC 17025 standard and adhering to U.S. Pharmacopeia (USP) guidelines, we report values exactly as measured rather than rounding or capping at 100%.

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
